

CORRECTINJECT FOR SPINAL ANAESTHESIA

The Portex CorrectInject safety system, from Smiths Medical, is a dedicated neuraxial connector system. The system's components have a unique non-Luer taper that only allows connection of compatible CorrectInject components. When used together as a system, this helps reduce the risk of misconnection and the chance of injecting medication not intended for the spinal space.

Misconnections, such as between intrathecal and intravenous lines, are common enough that NHS England has set a deadline requiring hospitals to use dedicated neuraxial medication delivery systems. These systems will need to have safer connectors, which will not connect with intravenous Luer connectors. The CorrectInject system promotes a safer way of administering a bolus of spinal anaesthesia.
